The Crook County Historical Society was formed in 1969 to record and preserve the history of our county, in which the recent history of all Central Oregon began.

In 1971, Alta Bowman and her daughters gave the Bowman Building to Crook County to be used as a museum, in memory of A. R. Bowman. The Crook County Historical Society converted the old stone building, which was built in 1910 as the Crook County Bank. This modern museum now shelters hundreds of items of historical value. Items are donated or taken on short term loan to the museum, so the Bowman Museum is now a depository of priceless articles which might otherwise be lost forever.

While the management of the Bowman Museum is the Society's principal project, other activities also carry on the preservation of our history.
